Location:

- Our offices are located in Moncton, NB but remote work from within Atlantic Canada is an option
- Must be available to attend Oasis in Wolfville, NS from August 5-8, 2026. (CBAC will cover transportation, lodging, and meals, if needed)

Role:

Working within CBAC's Communications department to support all aspects of CBAC's ministry.

This role includes:

- Support for video production, content creation through photography and graphic design
- Creating and managing digital and social media content, website updates, and email newsletters. Must be able to create graphics in accordance with provided brand guidelines (Adobe CC preferred, Canva, etc.)

Must meet eligibility to participate in Canada Summer Jobs:

- have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations
