Shift & schedule

Middle and Senior Youth – 2 evenings a week plus Sunday Morning: 10 hours per week

Job Summary:

This part time position (10 hours/week) is responsible for leading a growing youth ministry (middle school and senior high) providing Christ-centered, enthusiastic leadership to recruit, support, and maintain participation of youth.

The Youth Pastor will collaborate with the Board of Directors (Bod), the Christian Education Team and the Director of Discipleship plus ministry teams, and provide leadership to recruit, train and support youth volunteers. Reports to Bod.

Characteristics:

1. A grounded, Spirit - led Christ-follower with a deep personal relationship with Jesus.
2. Organized extrovert that loves teens.
3. Musical instrument and worship talent is an asset.
4. Camp experience or athletics is an asset.

HBC YOUTH WORKER JOB DESCRIPTION Draft

Job Type: Part-Time Interim Position

Church Youth Worker: To run youth groups on one or two evenings and interactive bible study on Sunday mornings

Job Purpose

To create a fun, stimulating and safe environment where young people from grade 6 to 8 and grade 9 to 12 will meet to engage with each other and have fun in an atmosphere where they can also invite others. The aim is to transform lives, equip them for effective service, and encourage them to grow spiritually and reach out to others, while serving as a spiritual leader and role model to the youth.

As a Youth Leader, you will join our church CE team; and collaborate with Director of Discipleship to build a youth work team, and help plant fresh expressions of church and community work amongst disaffected young people. This is an exciting opportunity to work with young people of all faiths and in a variety of settings.

Accountability

1. To be directly responsible to the Board for spiritual and ministry guidance.
2. Attend CE meetings and receive feedback at evaluation with the board.
3. Schedule is to be adjusted according to ministry needs.
4. Connect with other youth workers and organisations to attend youth events that are happening in the area.

Tentative Schedule

Evenings

- To be responsible to run a youth group for grade 6 to 8 and grade 9 to 12. Times to be determined

Sunday Mornings

- Develop and lead the HilzYouth Group, grade 6 to 12 on HilzYouth Connect Group Sunday mornings estimate 9 to 1030.

Other

1. Work with ministry leaders to ensure the smooth transition of children, from children's ministry to youth ministry.

2. To spend time engaging and inviting them to join in youth activities. Sports or Music initiatives after school.
3. Implement spiritual teaching material, resources for lessons and the delivery of the lesson.
4. To radically challenge the youth to be maturing spiritually and disciplined.
5. To devise programmes that will enable the youth to invite their friends to participate.
6. Encourage the youth to take up serving opportunities in the church and the community as a means of service to the Lord, training for future careers and potential experience gained.
7. Provision of pastoral care for designated young people.
8. Supervision of young people in your care at designated hours.
9. Provision of a supportive, caring and safe environment for the youth.
10. To adhere to Hillsborough Baptist Church motto of Love, Connect and Serve.
11. Train and mentor volunteers.
12. Work within the youth budget items with approval from the Christian Education Chair before spending. (Slips are in the office.)
13. All marketing communications shall be coordinated with The Director of Discipleship.

Person Specification

1. **Christian Character:** The youth worker must be a practising Christian and have a heart for God, and a desire to grow in faith, in agreement with the vision of the church.
2. **Personal Qualities:** The youth worker must have a passion for the youth and a pastoral heart to see the youth grow in their relationship with Christ.
3. **Spiritual Gifting:** Teacher, encourager, serving (Romans 12)
4. **Work Experience:** Youth Certificate and/or previous experience in youth work is essential but candidates/applicants with relevant experience or transferrable skills will also be considered.
5. **Youth worker** must be self-motivated, highly organised, energetic and practical, with a proven record of organising and delivering first rate youth group lessons.
6. **Managing change:** to be able to help young people transition from HilzYouth grade 12 to fully participate in the adult offered ministries at HBC.
