

FORM 1A

Form 1a, the Articles of Incorporation (the “**Articles**”) of a Newfoundland corporation is the basic incorporating document of a Newfoundland corporation. The Articles sets out basic information such as the name of the corporation, its head office, initial directors and members, and so forth. It also attaches Schedules A and B which relate to the purpose of the Corporation and the share capital.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING DRAFT ARTICLES

1. Enter the name of the corporation as set out in Section 2 of the Church Incorporation Instruction Sheet in paragraph 1.
2. Enter the address of the head office in paragraph 2.
3. Enter the minimum and maximum number of directors of the corporation. Note that this is guided by the By-laws. The default By-laws are for a minimum of 3 and maximum of 15 (see by-law 30). These directors will be the initial members of the corporation.
4. Enter the names of up to 6 incorporators, including their addresses and phone numbers. Each applicant must be at least 18 years old under the draft By-laws (see By-law 6).
