Job Description

Purpose and Accountability

The purpose of this role is to give leadership to and help facilitate the work of Christian Education among the youth of our congregation.

The *Church Youth Group Leader* will be accountable to the congregation through the Christian Education Committee and will function under the direction of the Senior Minister.

Responsibilities

The Church Youth Group Leader, in the following order of priority, will be responsible to:

- organize a youth group, designed primarily for young people in grade 5 or older, that meets on a regular basis.
- integrate youth as much as possible into active participation in the overall life of our church
- attend meetings of the Christian Education Committee, as requested.
- support, encourage, and serve as a resource to the Christian Education Committee
- support, encourage, and attend the various programs and activities of Christian Education within our church. These include, but are not limited to, DVBS, Advent and Lenten Workshops, the Church Family Picnic, and the Back-to-Sunday-School Brunch when available to do so.
- help integrate new families with youth into the life of our church
- promote the involvement of youth within outside, related ministries such as summer camps, mission trips or projects, and other activities or programs deemed beneficial to their spiritual and faith formation, and to the life and ministry of our congregation.
